- Take 20/59 South towards Tuscaloosa
- Take exit 123 to merge onto AL-4 W/US-78 W/Arkadelphia Rd
- Continue to follow AL-4 W/US-78 W (2.3 miles)
- Turn Left onto Hibernian Street
- Turn right to stay on Hibernian Street
- Turn left onto Mildred Avenue
- 310 Mildred Avenue will be located on the right
