


Dear Members of the Advent Family, Concert Series Patrons, and Attendees,

Our music ministry plays a vital role in our worship, and we are grateful to God for the gift of music and its provision in this place. Our special choral services and Cathedral Concert Series expand the opportunities for our parishioners to experience sacred music outside of regular worship, extend our ministry to the greater community, and contribute to the art and culture of our great city. Through the dedicated patronage of the Concert Series, we are able to present internationally renowned artists in concerts of sacred music here in Birmingham, Alabama.

The 2023-2024 season marks the 10th anniversary of the Cathedral Concert Series, and it promises to be our most exciting yet. We begin our season this fall with a recital by organist Margaret Harper, following Choral Evensong in November. In January, we celebrate Epiphanytide with a choral Epiphany Procession Service with Carols, followed by a seasonal organ recital given by organist Kevin Kwan. VOCES8 has become a beloved and frequent guest on our Concert Series, and will perform a special Lenten program in February. After Easter, our very own Cathedral Choir will present Handel's *Messiah* in its entirety on Friday, April 19, 2024 in collaboration with the North Carolina Baroque Orchestra and a slate of world-class soloists. Finally, I will play Olivier Messiaen's celebrated *L' Ascension* following our service of Choral Eucharist for Ascension Day in May.

James O'Donnell, formerly of Westminster Abbey and now organ professor at Yale University, will be with us on Sunday, February 11 to guest-conduct our choral services that morning, including a special service of Choral Matins at 11:00 a.m.

Please join me in thanking our Concert Series Patrons, whose generosity makes the Cathedral Concert Series possible. I also want to thank you all for your interest and support, and for keeping a love of sacred music alive in the city of Birmingham.

Organist Margaret Harper has performed in central Europe, Southeast Asia, and across the U.S. in noted venues including Methuen Memorial Music Hall, Saint Thomas Church (New York), St. Paul's Cathedral (Pittsburgh), and Harvard University, as well as for national conferences of the Organ Historical Society and the Association of Anglican Musicians. She holds a Doctor of Musical Arts degree and a Performer's Certificate from the Eastman School of Music, and has been hailed by The Diapason magazine for her "elegant performance" and by The Boston Musical Intelligencer for "outstandingly lively, punchy" playing. Dr. Harper is the newly appointed Director of Music of Trinity Church in Princeton, New Jersey, and appears on the roster of Concert Artist Cooperative.

Kevin Kwan currently serves as Organist and Director of Music at Christ and St. Luke's Episcopal Church in Norfolk, Virginia, only the fifth organist in the last 140 years to hold the post. For four years Mr. Kwan served as Assistant Organist at Saint Thomas Church Fifth Avenue in New York City, where he worked daily with the renowned Choir of Men and Boys under the direction of the late John Scott. Mr. Kwan also served as Organ Scholar at Gloucester Cathedral, where he enjoyed two international tours with the Choir of Men and Boys, was featured live on BBC Radio, and played in the historic Three Choirs Festival. As a recitalist, he has performed solo recitals in many prestigious venues, including Lichfield, Truro, Bristol, Westminster Cathedrals, as well as Bath Abbey and Westminster Abbey. In 2010, he played before a capacity audience at Passau Cathedral, Germany.

honored to welcome James O'Donnell, LVO as guest conductor for our morning choral services on the Last Sunday after the Epiphany, including a special service of Morning Prayer at 11:00 a.m. One of the most celebrated concert organists, choral conductors, and liturgical musicians of our time, James O'Donnell served for more than a decade as Master of Music at Westminster Cathedral and for more than two decades as Organist and Master of the Choristers (Director of Music) at Westminster Abbey. During his tenure at Westminster Abbey, O'Donnell directed the music for many nationally and internationally significant occasions, including the wedding of Prince William and Catherine Middleton (Duke and Duchess of Cambridge), the funeral of Queen Elizabeth II, and conducted the Choir of Westminster Abbey in many broadcasts, concerts, and tours. In January 2023, Mr. O'Donnell began his appointment as Professor in the Practice of Organ at the Yale School of Music and Institute of Sacred Music.



At the conclusion of Choral Eucharist for Ascension Day led by the Cathedral Choir, our Director of Music will perform *The Ascension*, a four-movement suite composed by Olivier Messiaen. The work was originally conceived for orchestra and completed in 1933. A year later Messiaen arranged the suite for organ, replacing the third movement with new music more idiomatic to the instrument. The evocative titles of each movement are descriptive images of the Ascension, powerfully painted by the music.
