Requirements:

- 1. Must be an active, confirmed member in good standing of the Advent.
- 2. Must be frequent and regular in worship attendance.
- 3. Must be committed to the gospel's work on non-believers, as well as on members of the Advent.
- 4. Must support the work of the Advent by a yearly pledge to the operating budget, and be willing to accept the tithe as the goal of Christian giving and percentage giving as a tool to reach that goal.
- 5. Must be willing and able to attend Vestry meetings and perform the work expected of a Vestry Member. (Vestry meetings are normally scheduled for the third Thursday of the month, except for July and December. There is also a Friday night/Saturday morning Vestry Retreat in February.)
- 6. Must not have served on the Vestry in 2023.
- 7. Must not be the spouse of a person who served on the Vestry in 2023.
- 8. Must not be employed directly by the Advent currently, or at any time in 2023, and must not be the spouse of a person who is currently employed. The term "employed directly" does not include professionals and others who are hired on an ad hoc basis to provide such services as legal, auditing, engineering, contracting, and similar services.
